| 1004 | Cockenzie Harbour | Robert Stevenson, engineer, 1835, incorporating part of earlier harbour of 17th century, W pier altered late 19th century. Tidal harbour of irregular polygonal form. W pier forms breakwater largely of hammer- faced squared and coursed rubble, with central section of old vertically coursed rubble. E pier larger, essentially L-shaped, in squared and coursed rubble, with 5 ft wall to seaward side. | 339770 | 675694 | Category B | LB23025 |

| 1120 | South Lodge, enclosure 200m SE of | The monument comprises a ditched enclosure of prehistoric date, visible as a cropmark on oblique aerial photographs. | 1176 | Preston,market cross | PRESTON, PRESTON CROSS: "Early 17th century. Yellow sandstone mercat cross, comprising round drum base surmounted by shaft. | 1182 | Birsley Brae,medieval coal mine | By the end of the 13th century coal was being worked (in Tranent parish) by the local lord as well as by the monks of Newbattle Abbey.
